

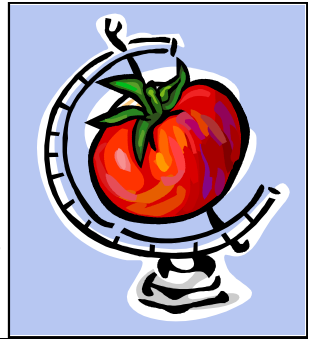

NEW AMBASSADOR MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM FOR 2012

The Board of Directors will allow for 25 new memberships from now until Memorial Day. This program will be similar to the program that was so successful last year. The initiation fee is \$500.00. Monthly dues are \$212.00, Dining Minimum is \$55.00, and contribution to the Capital Improvement Fund is \$15.00. The sponsoring member will also receive a reduction in dues to \$212.00 per month. 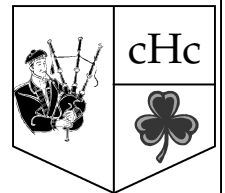

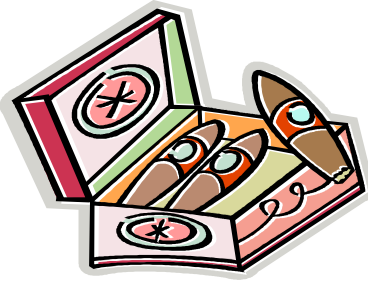
